

FAQ's about signature perspex art

where and how is my perspex artwork made?

your perspex artwork is designed and produced in australia. it's very different to a photograph mounted to perspex as light can interact with your signature perspex art creating a shadow play and a stunning 3D effect.

crystal clear perspex of 6mm thickness is used as the ultra-modern alternative to artist canvas. state of the art print technology and UV resistant inks for the best possible print. the edges are polished smooth, and stainless steel architectural "spacer" bolts are included for installation so it's ready to hang. once we're happy it's absolutely perfect is your artwork given the signature brand and authenticated as the genuine article.

what is meant by limited edition?

it means you're not buying a mass produced product. your artwork has will be one of only an exclusive 150 produced in any colourway and size. and your artwork will come with a hand signed, edition numbered card.

will the colours on screen look the same on my wall?

unfortunately, every screen and printer is calibrated differently, so we can't control how these colours appear to you. however, if you're concerned to ensure an exact match to your decor, we have the solution!

we've cross-referenced the key colours in each collection to their nearest dulux paint colour. interior designers will have complete dulux colour charts to hand, but your local paint retailer can provide you with individual paint chips. how do i hang my perspex artwork?

your perspex art is supplied with the necessary mounting bolts, ready to hang. if you would like your panoramic piece to hang vertically, or a rectangular piece to hang portrait style, that's entirely your choice.

installing your artwork requires slightly more precision than hanging a canvas, but it's not rocket science! the holes in the perspex provide the template for where to drill the holes in your wall, and there is a degree of "play" between the hole diameter and the bolt diameter to allow for fine adjustments. a spirit level is handy. once installed, your perspex artwork will "float" about 25mm off your wall.

is it heavy?

perspex is considerably lighter, not to mention less fragile, than glass. a significant benefit. the weight of your artwork depends of course on the dimensions you've chosen. use 10kg per square metre as a guide.

can i hang my perspex artwork outside?

one of the advantages that perspex art has over an artist canvas is that it can be used in environments where canvas artworks would suffer. it's perfect for your outdoor room, spaces such as kitchens and bathrooms, or anywhere in a very humid climate!

whilst we use the best UV resistant inks, as with all printed materials, fading may occur if your perspex art is displayed in continuous, strong sunlight over a number of years.

how do i care for my perspex artwork?

your artwork needs to be handled with care, like any artwork. perspex can scratch quite easily so only remove the masking paper/film protecting the surface once you've secured your artwork to the wall.

clean using a mild soap and water solution and a non-abrasive, soft cloth being very careful not to scratch the perspex surface in any way.
